



Echofluxx 19 Press Release

Echofluxx 19, a Prague new media, art and music festival, will be held at Paralelní Polis May 1-4, 2019 under the direction of Dan Senn, cofounder of Roulette Intermedium, New York City. The 9th consecutive year, this year's lineup of international presenters will feature experimental video, sound art, free improvisation, poetry and contemporary classical music free to the public.

The festival will begin Wednesday, May 1st, at 19:30h, with the Echofluxx International Film Festival with works by Jenny E. Balisle, Lynn Bianchi, Ben Lieberman & Bradley Turner, William A. Brown, and Young Shin-Choi" followed by Jan Kruml, and **Ensemble Terrible** from FAMU with works by J-T Vesikkala Wittmacher, Ravi Kittappa, Soňa Vetchá, Barry Wan Yuk Bun, and Bruno Cunha.

On Thursday, May 2nd, at 19:30h, the festival will continue with the Film Festival with works by Brigid Burke, Diego Ratto & Hans Richter, Nicola Frattegiani, and Nathan Corder followed by a special work by Jana Babincová & Pavlína Zábranská. Next up is Phaerentz with his live electronic improvisations followed by Brigid Birke, this time live with electronics and video.

Friday night, May 3rd, at 19:30h, will begin with Film Festival offerings by Edward Ramsay-Morin, Jacek J. Kolasiński & Orlando Jacinto Garcia, Sonja Mutić, and Harvey Goldman & Jing Wang. Then a new film by Phill Niblock and William Hooker followed by a reading of poetry by James Sutherland-Smith, and then Hearn Gadbois on drums.

The final evening, Saturday, May 4th, at 19:30h, will start with experimental films from Dong Zhou & Liz Yi Sun, Charles Peck, Anthony Almedárez, Lana Z Caplan, Talksong Lee & Jee Seo, followed by the Echofluxx Ensemble performing "Perfect" with David Means as director. The final act will feature Bruno Cunha wielding his incredible clarinet accompanied by live electronics.
